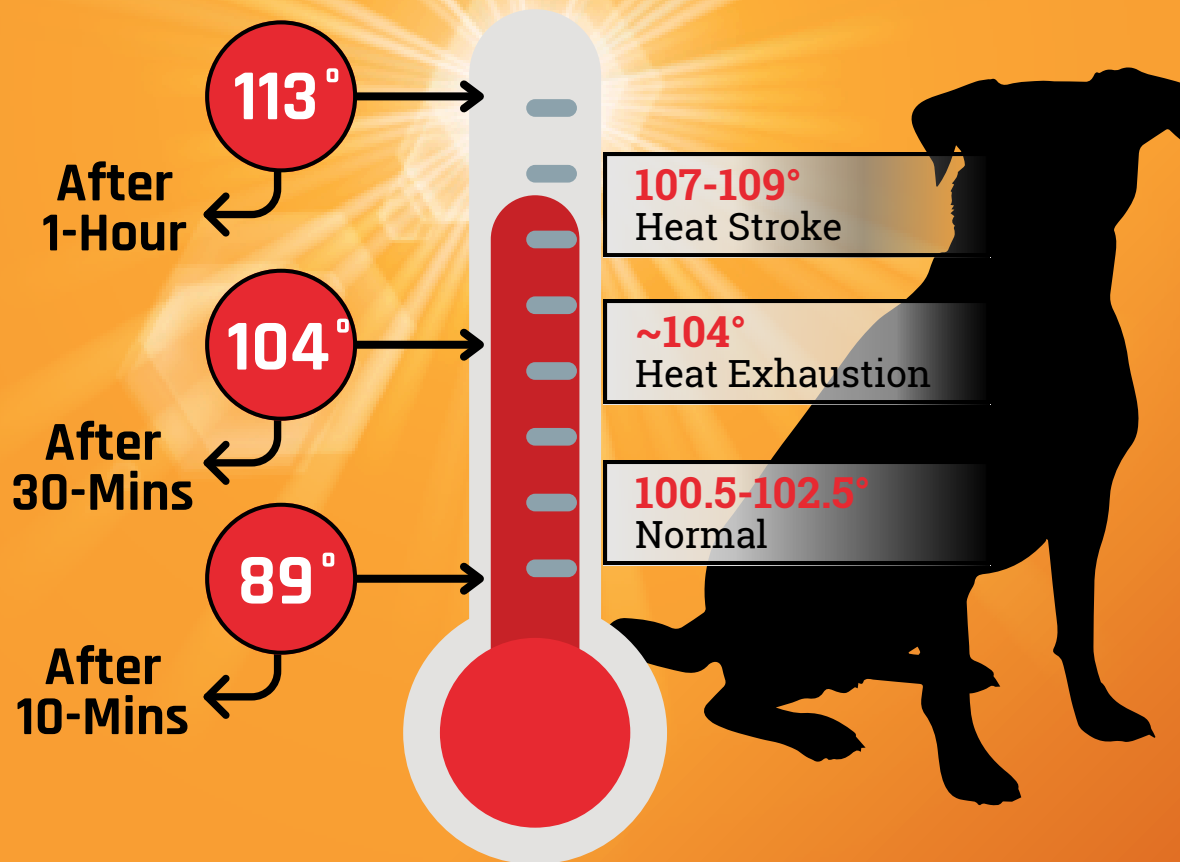

Signs of a Heat Stroke

- Heavy Panting
- Difficulty Breathing
- Excessive Thirst
- Bright Red Tongue & Mucus Membranes (which turns gray as shock sets in)
- Thick Saliva, Drooling, Vomiting and/or Diarrhea
- Unsteadiness and Staggering
- Lethargy
